



## APPENDIX B. PARTICIPATION MATRIX AND DOCUMENTATION

The matrix in Appendix B is intended to give a broad overview of FEMA, the State of New Jersey, county, municipal and stakeholder personnel that participated in the Cape May County HMP update planning process. Meeting attendees and input provided are also included. All participants were encouraged to attend the kick-off meeting and mitigation workshop. During the planning process the consultant contacted each participant to offer support, explain the process, and facilitate the submittal and review of critical documents.

The participating jurisdictions agreed to abide by the Planning Partner Expectations and Planning Committee Guidelines which established a Steering Committee. Letters of Intent to Participate indicating municipal planning efforts are included in this appendix. The Steering Committee served as the core of the working group. Participation is defined as having input to the hazard analysis (providing critical facility, hazard event, vulnerability data), and as having participated in the mitigation workshop or alternate annex meetings as described in the HMP for the purpose of creating a mitigation strategy to be included in each municipalities annex in Section 9. A list of participating jurisdictions and representatives is found in **Table B-1**.

A number of stakeholders were invited to participate in the planning process. Stakeholders were invited to meetings, asked to complete a stakeholder survey, requested to provide input on their involvement in Cape May County and flood protection, and review and comment on the draft plan. A list of stakeholders and their participation is found in **Table B-2**.

The development and review of jurisdictional annexes involved the participation of the county, municipal and stakeholder personnel. The representatives involved in annex development and review and their contributions to the jurisdictional annexes are identified in **Table B-3**.

A Strengths, Weakness, Obstacles and Opportunities exercise (SWOO) was completed by the planning partnership. Participants were asked to fill out the SWOO for each of the hazards of concern for the 2021 HMP update. The results were compiled and presented to the planning partnership at the risk assessment presentation. The results were also used by the participants to help identify capabilities and potential mitigation actions. The results from this activity are found in **Table B-4**.

In preparation for the draft plan public review, each jurisdiction was asked to have their ‘mitigation team’ review their annex to ensure it was complete and accurate for posting to the Cape May County Department Office of Emergency Management’s mitigation website. To demonstrate broad and comprehensive review and input, each jurisdiction collected signatures from these representatives. Copies of the sign-off sheets are provided at the end of this appendix.
